The Emergency Fund provides immediate financial assistance to help low income Chicago area individuals and families through a crisis or transition.

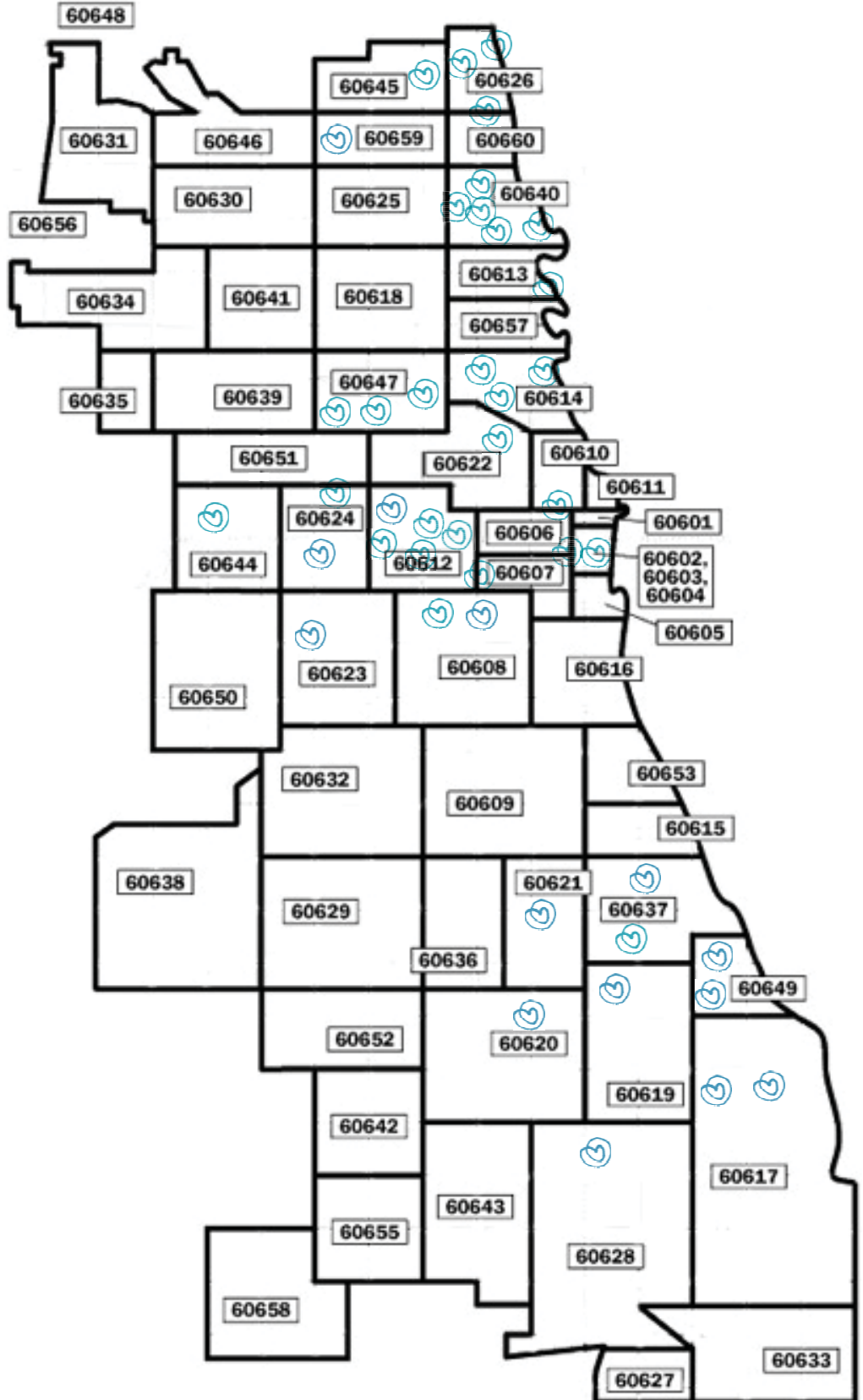
